

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL

March 14, 2020**

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL:

A. 10:00 A.M. Emergency City Council Meeting-Call the Meeting to Order

The Emergency Meeting of the City of Fontana City Council was held on Saturday, March 14, 2020, at the Grover W. Taylor Council Chambers, located at 8353 Sierra Avenue, Fontana, California. Mayor Warren called the meeting to order at 10:13 a.m.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Mayor Warren, Mayor Pro Tem Armendarez, Council Members Roberts, Sandoval and Cothran.

B. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

Following the Invocation by Council Member Roberts, the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Sandoval.

C. Public Communications

San Bernardino County Supervisor Josie Gonzales provided an update on the County of San Bernardino's plan and efforts in dealing with the COVID-19 Crisis.

Fontana Unified School District Superintendent Randall Basset spoke on the School District's plan to deal with the COVID-19 crisis.

Terri Schneider with the Fontana Boys and Girls Club spoke on their plan of action during the COVID-19 crisis.

D. New Business Item

Fontana Fire District Chief Jeff Birchfield spoke on the Fire District's plan to address the COVID-19 crisis. Chief Birchfield asked that anyone calling 911 should let the dispatchers know if they have flu like symptoms.

Fontana Police Chief Billy Green spoke on the Police Department's plan to address the COVID-19 crisis. Chief Green encouraged everyone to remain calm and act responsibly.

Community Services Director Garth Nelson provided an update on the closing of all community and neighborhood centers. Director Nelson stated that frozen meals will be delivered to seniors that are currently signed up to receive meals. Director Nelson reported that Community Services will

continue to transport seniors to appointments and grocery stores.

Discussion ensued on the After School Program and how it will operate during the COVID-19 crisis.

Public Works Director Keith Kramer provided an update on efforts to clean and sanitize city facilities.

Emergency Services Officer Aminah Mears announced that the Emergency Operations Center had been activated and spoke on a plan of action during the COVID-19 crisis.

Action: Motion was made by Council Member Sandoval, seconded by Council Member Roberts, and passed by a vote of 5-0 to approve New Business Item "A" (AYES: Warren, Armendarez, Roberts, Sandoval and Cothran; NOES: None; ABESNT: None) as follows:

1 . Adoption of Resolution No. 2020-020, ratifying the Director of Emergency Services' proclamation of existence of a local emergency.

Elected Officials Communications:

City Treasurer Janet Koehler-Brooks thanked staff for stepping up during the COVID-19 crisis and offered prayers to the community.

Mayor Pro Tem Armendarez thanked the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors for taking action on the COVID-19 crisis and commended all agencies for working together to get through the crisis and protect the community.

Council Member Sandoval thanked everyone for working together during the crisis and shared words of encouragement to the community.

Council Member Roberts stated that the COVID-19 crisis will be a big challenge and asked that the community be kept in prayer during this time.

Council Member Cothran shared a story of strangers coming together and helping one another during the COVID-19 crisis.

Mayor Warren spoke on staff's efforts to deal with the COVID-19 crisis and also thanked all those that spoke and provided updates.

Mayor Warren encouraged the community to have patience and that we will all get through this together.

E. Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 11:19 a.m. to the next Regular City Council Meeting on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, with a Workshop at 5:30 p.m. in the City Hall Executive Conference Room and the Regular Meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Grover W. City Attorney Ruben Duran announced that the Mayor and Council were convening to Closed Session under authority of Government Code 54957(a) allowing the Mayor and Council to continue to discuss issues of public security in a confidential setting.
