

Annual Self Inspection Program

Fontana Fire Protection District will be implementing a self inspection program over the next 2 years to assist and educate low hazard, local business owners who will perform a self inspection assessment annually to identify and alleviate fire hazards throughout your occupancy and maintain a safe work environment for you, your employees and the general public. Low hazard businesses are by definition* those who fall into the “B” or “M” occupancy category.

Goal of the Self Inspection Program – This program was developed to assist business owners with the most effective and efficient means to comply with Fire Code Ordinances with minimal disruption to business operations.

What you can expect - Your local Fontana Fire Fighters will be visiting your business to assist you in the initial orientation and implementation of this program. Subsequent annual inspections will be performed by the business owner and submitted electronically through our Fontana Fire Prevention website for your convenience.

***Business Group B.** Business Group B occupancy includes, among others, the use of a building or structure, or a portion thereof, for office, professional or service-type transactions, including storage of records and accounts.

Mercantile Group M. Mercantile Group M occupancy includes, among others, the use of a building or structure or a portion thereof, for the display and sale of merchandise, and involves stocks of goods, wares or merchandise incidental to such purposes and accessible to the public.
