

POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

January 2025



NOTEWORTHY EVENTS

- Fontana Police Special Operations seized over 200 kilos of cocaine, 10 pounds of methamphetamine, over 30,000 fentanyl pills, and dismantled an active methamphetamine lab. In addition to the narcotics seized, they seized 61 illegal firearms.
- Chief Dorsey hosted a Business Watch Forum.
- Fontana Police participated in the annual “Shop with a Senior” event at Walmart, providing support to over 20 Fontana seniors.
- ICAC Investigators arrested several individuals for possession of child pornography.
- Fontana Police Detectives investigated a homicide of a local business owner. The investigation led to the identification and arrest of the suspect.
- Fontana Police conducted an on-line public awareness campaign relating to the dangers of electric bicycles/motorcycles.




