

Fontana PD's MET Outreach unit (H.O.S.T) consists of one police officer, one San Bernardino County probation officer and one San Bernardino Department of Behavior Health H.O.S.T personnel. This team will go out in the field and proactively engage with homeless individuals, some of which need to be contacted multiple times in order to build rapport and gain trust with the team.
