NOTEWORTHY EVENTS

- Fontana Police participated in the annual “Flame of Hope” Law Enforcement Run for Special Olympics.
- Chief Dorsey hosted a Business Watch Meeting with local business owners.
- Fontana Police continued outreach and partnered with the Inland Regional Center to showcase the “Blue Envelope Program.”
- Special Operations seized over 21 pounds of methamphetamine, 65 kilos of cocaine, over 17,000 illegal fentanyl pills, and recovered over 2 million dollars of stolen property and cargo.

- COPE partnered with Walmart and provided support to their law enforcement appreciation event.




